RULE FOR WITHDRAWAL OF ADMISSION FORMS

Rule 12.1

An admission form of a candidate once submitted may be withdrawn by the Head of an Institution only under the following conditions: -

- (i) When a candidate has been sent up provisionally on account of shortage of attendances and that shortage has not been made up or condoned in accordance with the rules.
- (ii) If the attendances of a candidate run short of the required percentage although his/her name had previously been forwarded by the Head of institution to appear in the examination and the shortage is not condoned or is so much as cannot be condoned in accordance with the rules.
- (iii) When a candidate's name has been struck off the rolls of an institution for non-payment of college/school dues provided such action has been taken before the commencement of the examination.
- (iv) When a candidate has been rusticated or expelled or his character certificate has been withdrawn for misconduct before the conclusion of the examination.

Rule 12.2

A candidate may be sent up provisionally if he is likely to make the grade in respect of satisfactory class work by the end of the session, failing which his name may be withdrawn 14 days before the commencement of the examination.
