In continuation to this office Notification No.71/14 dated 14-10-2014, it is hereby notified for the information of all concerned that the Board in its meeting dated 18-11-2016 vide item No.22 has confirmed the following decision of PBCC meeting dated 23-08-2016 vide item No.6 regarding amendment in Board Calendar Chapter No.01 Rule No.08:-

<u>EXISTING RULE</u>	<u>APPROVED AMENDMENT</u>
<p>The Student who fails or obtains less than 33% marks in one or more subjects or remains absent in Part-I (Class-IX) examination, may be re-admitted in Part-I (9th) with the changed / same combination of subjects / group in the same or in any other institution.</p> <p>However, the passed candidate will get his/her result cancelled from the Board after giving undertaking on Stamp Paper that he/she never appeared in 10th Class. He/she will not be entitled for the position at any stage. Position will be the right of those students who admitted first time in the Institution.</p> <p>The student who fails or obtains less than 33% marks in one or more subjects or remains absent in Part-I (Class-XI) examination, may be re-admitted in Part-I with the changed / same combination of subjects / group in the same or in any other institution.</p> <p>However, the passed candidate will get his/her result cancelled from the Board after giving undertaking on Stamp Paper that he/she never appeared in Part-II. He/she will not be entitled for the position at any stage. Position will be the right of those students who admitted first time in the Institution.</p>	<p>If a regular candidate remains absent / obtains less than 33% marks in Subject/s in 9th, and 11th Class exam, is eligible to get Re-Admission within 30 days of the date of declaration of the Result in the same Group/Combination or any other subjects he/she desires to study subject to payment of Rs. 1000/- as re-admission fee (Payable to Board). The previous Registration of the students will remain intact. The Head of Institution shall forward the complete data of the re-admitted student to the Board within (15) fifteen days of re-admission.</p> <p>However, the passed candidates will get re-admission after cancellation of his/her (9th, 11th)-result from the Board within 30 days of the date of declaration of result subject to payment of Rs. 1000/- as re-admission fee of the result in the same Group/Combination or any other subjects he/she desires to study. His/her previous registration will remain intact. The Head of Institution shall forward the complete data of the re-admitted student to the Board within (15) fifteen days of re-admission. The candidate shall also have to deposit fee Rs.1000/- for cancellation of his /her result as prescribed by the Board for this purpose. The candidate will provide an undertaking on a stamp paper that he/she will not be entitled for the position at any stage. Position will be right of those students who admitted first time in the Institution. Re-admission shall be one time only.</p> <p>If a private candidate remains fail/absent/ obtains less than 33% marks in subject/s in the 9th or 11th class examination is eligible to get re-admission in any institution within 30 days of the date of declaration of the result subject to payment of Rs. 1000/- (Payable to Board) and the Head of the Institution shall forward complete data of the re-admitted student to the Board within 15 days of re-admission or to re-appear as a private candidate in the forthcoming 9th or 11th class examination. In both circumstances the previous registration of the candidate shall remain intact.</p>
